## How The Pono Process Works

Step 1: Youth submits a grievance (website, email, phone)

Step 2: Pono Navigator receives the grievance

Step 3: Pono Navigator follows up with youth

Step 4: Pono Navigator informs youth's team about grievance

Step 5: Youth and team work on a resolution

Step 6: If no resolution - Pono Protectors join youth and team to seek a resolution

Step 7: If no resolution - Pono Protectors/team will assist youth with exploring legal options

Youth's Team: Social Worker, GAL/CASA, Resource Caregivers

<u>Pono Protector</u>: Professionals assigned by Judiciary and CWS to assist with grievances
